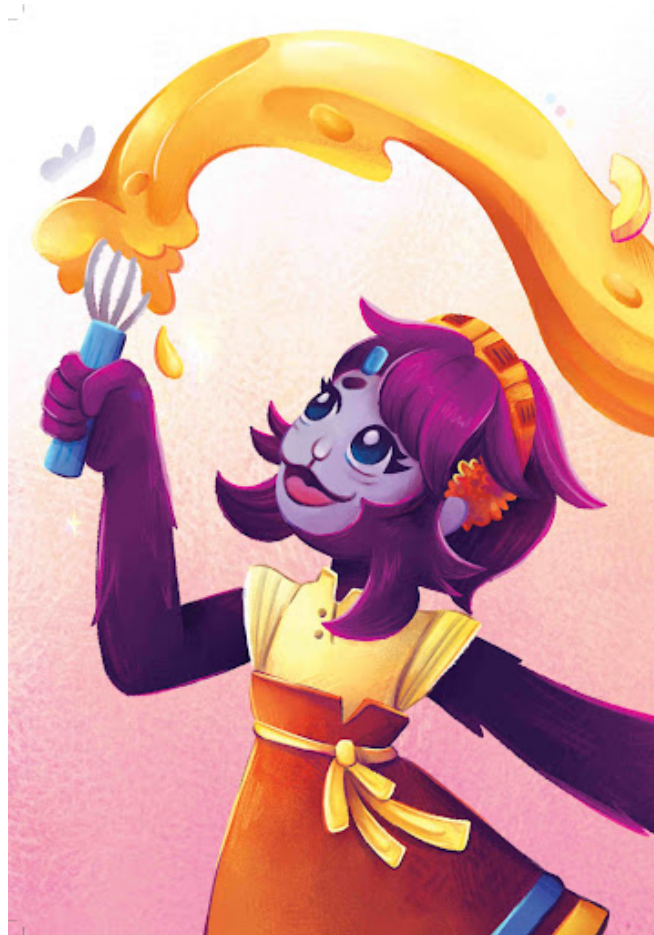
It's August!
